## Admission tickets INCLUDE participation in:

Poker run, treasure hunt, trail riding, challenge course, wheelie contests, teeter -totter contests and one Sport or Utility class (drag race) at NO EXTRA CHARGE. These prices also INCLUDE your spectator admission to ALL EVENTS.

**Treasure Hunt:** Look for something that does not belong along the trail, in the woods, or maybe even at one of the Poker Run stops in the village of Tigerton. Bring your finding back to the scoring tower to claim your "treasure." Every item hid and found is worth a prize. You can participate in the treasure hunt at any time throughout the weekend (remember the trails will be closed from 8:00 AM to Noon on Saturday). This activity is included in your paid weekend admission

**Poker Run:** Starts at 10:00am Saturday and runs through noon Sunday. Pick up your "stamp card" at the "Motozone" concession stand. Stop at each location to get stamped. Return card to the "Motozone" concession area before noon on Sunday to draw your poker hand. Winners will be announced at 2 PM Sunday at the main "Motozone" tower. Must be present to claim prizes.

**Wheelie Contests, Side Wheelie Contest:** Not sure we really need to explain this, do we? These contests will take place on the drag strip Saturday evening after all other events are completed for the day. Bring your lawn chair for some great evening entertainment! Open to everyone - space will be limited.

**Teeter Totter:** The teeter totter will be available throughout the weekend for "play". The contests will take place near the drag strip Saturday evening after all other events are completed for the day. Description - exactly what it sounds like. We've built a 50 foot long, eight foot wide teeter totter specifically for ATV's. Sounds crazy but sure is fun! Activity #1 - "balancing act" - how long can you "balance" the teeter totter? Activity #2 - "Team Teeter Totter" - how many times can you teeter the totter in two minutes?
